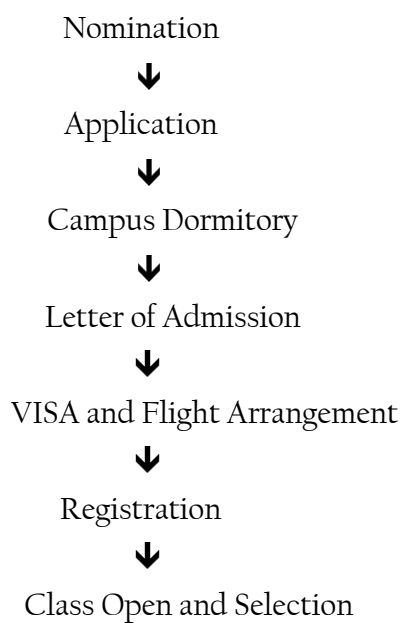

## ■ VISA

Please visit the website of the Bureau of Consular Affairs, Ministry of Foreign Affairs for the required documents while applying for a VISA.

■ **One-Academic year** :Please apply for a Resident Certificate within 15 days after entering Taiwan.

■ **One-Semester** :Please apply for an extension of your visitor VISA within 15 days after entering Taiwan.

NOTE:

■ Students are advised not to enter Taiwan with a landing VISA.

■ Students for the one-year exchange program are advised to apply for a resident VISA before entering Taiwan.



## ■ Flight Arrangement

- After applying for a VISA and confirming the flight, students need to upload the information onto the designated website and ensure that airport pick-up services to campus.
- If students need airport pick-up service, please follow the "Airport Pick-up Services" information below when students buy the flight ticket.

## ■ Airport Pick-up Services

- This service may alter according to each semester, detail will be announced before every semester begins, If students need airport pick-up service, please follow the timetable that we provide.
- Please fill in the form that attached with this letter as soon as possible.
- Please know that airport pick-up service is **only** offered to "Kaohsiung Airport (KHH), for those who plans on landing Taoyuan International Airport(TPE), airport pick-up service might not be provided. We are sorry for the inconvenience.



## ■ Dormitory

### ■ Dorm types:

■ We offer a variety of housing options at different price points across our residence halls for each semester (fall and spring semesters, four-and-a-half months.). Fees are based on room types, hall amenities, and number of occupants, and include furnishings, a telephone line, smoke alarm and sprinkler, and wireless internet coverage. Residence hall washer and dryer use are **not** included in housing fees.



1. Beiyuan 2-bed suites (with kitchen) NT\$22,300 .
2. Beiyuan 3-bed suites (with kitchen) NT\$15,600
3. Beiyuan 2-bed suites (without kitchen) NT\$18,200.

■ Winter/Summer breaks dormitory fee (Less than one month, will be charged daily.) :

1. Beiyuan 2-bed suites (with kitchen) 1 Day NT\$204 (\*2025)
2. Beiyuan 3-bed suites (with kitchen) 1 Day NT\$166 (\*2025)
3. Beiyuan 2-bed suites (without kitchen) 1 Day NT\$175 (\*2025)

■ Whoever choose to stay in dorms during summer or winter breaks should go to Administration Building 2F(Student Life Guidance Section)to fill in the application at the end of the semester.

■ The Deposit: NT\$3,000.

■ The Key card deposit: NT\$300.

■ Dorm fees and other fees may vary according to new semester, and all the prices will be charged before each semester begins.

■ Check-in and check-out need to be in the office time.

- The dorm fee can either be paid in school, or can by overseas remittance.
- All the fees above refer to the 2025 announcement.

## ■ Tuition fee

- Tuition and the related fees for international exchange program will be waived to 0, according to the signed contracts with the MOU.

## ■ Other information

- Students insurance is currently not provided to international exchange students. For those up for participating international exchange students program in need of buying insurance will be suggested should do it in your home countries.



# Registration

Place: Office of International and Cross-Strait Affairs, 3rd Floor, Administration Building

## ■ Documents Required for Registration

1. Passport and a photocopy of the passport ID page (with the photo)
2. A photocopy of the visa page of the passport
3. Insurance document
4. A Copy of Certificate of Health Examination
5. Accommodation Agreement (will be provided after registration)

■ One academic year: Students of the one-year exchange program need a copy of the Health Certificate for Residence Application for applying for the resident certificate.

■ One semester: Students of the one-semester exchange program need a copy of the Health Certificate.

Students get to pay their application fees here in KSU.



## ■ Class Open and Selection



■ After arriving the school earlier than the semester starts for days. Students get to Select their courses at their department office, there is going to be a staff by your side to help collect your courses right on the spot.

■ Exchange students can choose all of the courses in our system if the course does not have teaching conditions or a limit on the number.

■ Students can find teaching conditions and a limit on the number on our website.



## ■ Climate

In Taiwan, formerly Formosa, an island in East Asia crossed by the Tropic of Cancer, there is a humid subtropical climate, with a very mild winter from December to February and a sultry, rainy summer from June to September. The summer rains are due to the monsoon, while in the other seasons, rainfall depends on latitude and slope exposure.

### ■ Spring (March-May)

- Average Temperature: 23-30° C
- Features: Wet and rainy, it is the rainy season from April-May.
- Dressing advice: This weather is unpredictable, recommend bringing rain gear running and wearing clothes in an

onion-style way.

### ■ Summer (June-September)

- Average Temperature: 26-32° C
- Features: Hot and humid, thunderstorms always occur afternoon, sometimes typhoons hit and bring s a lot of rain.
- Dressing advice: Bringing rain gear for running and wear clothes with short sleeves.

### ■ Fall (October-November)

- Average Temperature: 20-28° C  
(CCU: 16-25° C )
- Features: Dry and stable but always have Indian summer, sometimes have typhoons.
- Dressing advice: Wearing clothes in an onion-style way.

### ■ Winter (December-February)

- Average Temperature: 13-26° C
- Features: Northern is cold and wet, south is dry and moderate.
- Dressing advice: Wearing clothes with long sleeve. Sometimes cold spell hits for a week .

### ■ Sunrise

- Summer:Approx. 05:00-18:00 °
- Winter:Approx. 06:00-17:00 °

## Food Culture

■ Three meals a day: We are inherited in the Chinese culture, always have rice and noodles with chopsticks. Following globalization, Taiwan has a lot of food from overseas. If students miss their hometown flavor, it won't be hard to find a similar restaurant they missed.

■ Food types: Taiwanese food is well-known around the world. We have many different kinds of fruits from every season. Boba milk is always a signature, you can find it almost everywhere in Taiwan. Taiwan is surrounded by ocean hence we have a lot of seafood. Various of Taiwanese street food can also easily be found in night markets. Welcome to KSU and enjoy your stay here in Taiwan.

■ Vegetarian: Either in health or religion-oriented conditions, or none-pork meals for Muslim friends, we have several choices here in Taiwan.



## Transportation

### Public transport

Students can easily find the taxi or UBER here in Taiwan, still, public transportation can be paid by "EasyCard" or "either by iPass.

If students want to have a road trip. We have many automatic systems that can rent cars, scooters, and bicycles in the Tainan streets if they pass the online application.

## Living expenses

### Public transportation fee

Taipei MRT: NT\$ 20-65 (one trip)

Tainan Bus: NT\$15 (one trip)

Taxi: NT\$140-300 (one trip)
